Bids were opened and read by the Drain Commissioner with the results being noted above, with Payjay, Inc. being the apparent low bidder and Davis Construction as number 2 for Divisions I, with Woodhull Construction being the apparent low bidder and Kalin Construction as number 2 for Division II, with Quantum Construction being the apparent low bidder and Kalin Construction number 2 for Division III, and with JF New being the apparent low bidder and Native Connections number 2 for Division IV. Division IV included bids for plants and assisting in the planting. Bids were referred to Engineer Larry Protasiewicz, Spicer Group, Inc. and Drain Commissioner Roger Zilke for bid tabulation check and his recommendation.

Bid tabulations will be mailed out to bidding contractors.

The cashier's check from D.A. D'Agostino for Division III was returned to bidder following bid opening.
